Rules & Regulations:

- The show is for riders aged 19 years and under as at January 1, 2024
- The show committee reserves the right to **CANCEL, COMBINE OR DIVIDE CLASSES AS THE ENTRIES WARRANT.**
- **CLASSES WITH OVER 20 HORSES MAY BE SPLIT INTO TWO CLASSES.** This show is run in accordance with nationally recognized show rules. These rules will be adhered to.
- 1. This is a **TRAINING SHOW!** However, any unruly or disruptive horses **WILL** be excused from the class! Show clothes are **NOT** required! All tack must be safe and serviceably sound. At the judge's discretion horses ridden with excessive training equipment may not be placed.
 - a. English Classes: English type saddle, bridle with a snaffle bit, Pelham or double bridle (chinstrap for leverage type bits). Proper boots with a heel are required.
 - b. Western classes: Western saddle with saddle blanket or pad. Bridle can be either snaffle or a curb (leverage) bit. Leverage bits must be equipped with a proper leather or flat chain chinstrap. Rider must have a boot with a heel.
- 2. **NOTICE: SAHA requires that all junior riders wear ASTM safety approved helmets when riding on the grounds and in ALL classes at its shows including Showmanship, In Hand Obstacles, Costume and Lead-line classes**
- 3. Childs age is as at January 1, 2024
- 4. Stallions are not permitted at the show.
- 5. **ALL HORSES MUST BE KEPT SECURE** (Absolutely no tying to the hitching ring). All Dogs (on leash) and Children must be controlled on the show grounds for the safety of everyone.
- 6. Horses showing signs of a contagious disease will not be permitted to enter the show grounds. If your horse is sick PLEASE leave him/her at home.
- 7. Water will be available; **BRING YOUR OWN BUCKETS** – Feed **WILL NOT** be supplied – **BRING YOUR OWN**
- 8. Abuse of horses **WILL NOT** be tolerated on the show grounds
- 9. Riding at excessive speed or in an unsafe manner will **NOT** be tolerated.
- 10. ***THERE WILL BE GARBAGE CONTAINERS PROVIDED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS PLEASE USE THEM!

Showmanship Classes:

1. Halter Showmanship - 10 and Under
2. Halter Showmanship - 11-13
3. Halter Showmanship -14-18

English Classes:

4. English/Hunter Pleasure – Walk/Trot - no rider cross entry with canter classes
5. English/Hunter Pleasure – Walk/Trot/ Canter – no rider cross entry with walk/trot classes
6. English/ Hunter Equitation –Assisted Walk/Trot - no rider cross entry with walk/trot or canter classes
7. English Equitation – Walk/Trot - no rider cross entry with canter classes
8. English Equitation – Walk/Trot/ Canter – no rider cross entry with walk/trot classes

Jumping Classes (Arena 1 – to run simultaneously with Obstacle Classes)

9. Poles (no rider cross entry with class 11 and 12)
10. Cross Rails (not to exceed 18") (no rider cross entry with class 11 and 12)
11. 2'0" Equitation over fences (judged on equitation when jumping) (no rider cross entry with class 9 and 10)
12. 2'0" Hunter Hack (no rider cross entry with class 9 and 10)

Obstacle Classes (Arena 2 – to run simultaneously with Jumping Classes)

13. In Hand Obstacles – 13 and under
14. In Hand Obstacles – 14 – 18 years
15. Trail (English or Western) – Walk/Trot –no rider cross entry with lope classes (Assisted Walk Trot permitted)
16. Trail (English or Western) – Walk/Trot/ Lope

17. Costume Class
18. Bareback \$5 Bill (Winner Take All!)
19. Bobbing for Apples (Assister Walk/Trot Permitted)
20. Lead Line (FREE)

26. Western Equitation - Walk/Jog/ Lope – no cross entry with walk/ trot classes

30. Pole Bending – Lope – no rider cross entry with walk/trot classes

RELEASE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

EVERY PARTICIPANT IN the Strathcona All-Breed Horse Association's ("SAHA") YOUTH ONLY OPEN HORSE SHOW SHALL CAREFULLY READ THIS NOTICE BEFORE SIGNING; NO PARTICIPANT SHALL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE PRIOR TO SIGNING THIS FORM AS REQUIRED.

"Inherent risks of equine activities"; shall mean those dangers or conditions which are integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to:

(1) The propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity.

(2) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sound, sudden movements and unfamiliar objects, person or other animals;

(3) Collisions with other equines, animals people and objects;

(4) The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to the participant or others such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability. Neither SAHA, Strathcona Olympiette Centre (Fultonvale), Colchester Agricultural Society (or any other venue), YOUTH ONLY OPEN SHOW, the organizing committee, the show committee, officials volunteers, staff, nor agents shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury damage, loss or for any other matter that may happen to exhibitors, competitors, owners agents or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal or article brought to the grounds.

It is to be understood and agreed that by making any entry in SAHA's YOUTH ONLY OPEN HORSE SHOW, all exhibitors, competitors, owners agents and representatives acknowledge that equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risks and do hereby indemnify and hold harmless the SAHA, Strathcona Olympiette Centre (Fultonvale), Colchester Agricultural Society (or any other venue) YOUTH ONLY OPEN HORSE SHOW, and singular, the owners, directors, officers, members, employees, agents and volunteers thereof from and against any and all loss, costs or expenses, or any claim thereof of whatever nature arising for and on account, or by reason of participation in this show.
